

MARION SWIMMING CLUB CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership

Right of membership to Marion Swimming Club (MSC/the Club) is not automatic, but rather is subject to acceptance to the Club by the MSC Executive. Continued membership is contingent on fulfilling these Conditions of Membership. SwimmingSA requires a parent/guardian to join both SwimmingSA, SAL and MSC for all under 18 members.

Technical Officials and Timekeeping

SwimmingSA require all SA clubs to supply technical officials and timekeepers for all SwimmingSA meets. It is therefore a **compulsory** requirement for all MSC members to volunteer to fill these roles, as required by the Club. Failure to volunteer as a technical official or timekeeper may result in the club taking action, including but not limited to cancelling membership and/or withdrawing swimmers from meets.

Fundraising

All members and their families are required to assist with fundraising activities, including but not limited to the bi-annual MSC carnivals, BBQs, club meets, raffles and product sales.

Publication

By becoming a member of MSC you give consent to the publication of your/your child's name, photo(s) and results in any of our publications, emails, website content, or any other form of social media.

Proof of Age and Citizenship

SwimmingSA requires all clubs to sight and copy a swimmer's birth certificate or passport for all new members to the club.

Contact Information

The Club uses your registration contact information to circulate MSC material and other important information. It is the member's responsibility to ensure their contact information is up to date.

Other Policies

MSC has a Dry Team Policy in that no MSC team member is allowed to drink alcohol or take/use any recreational drug of any kind. Recreational drugs include any listed as illegal in any State or Territory in Australia. Any team member who breaches the policy is liable to have their membership from the team and club terminated.
