MEET PROCEDURES

SEEDINGS

Events will be seeded according to nomination times and not age groups or category.

COMPETITOR & SPECTATOR SEATING & POOL DECK ACCESS

Whilst the pool deck will not be out of bounds to persons other than competitors and officials, we kindly request that coaches, team managers, spectators and swimmers take seats in the main grandstand whilst watching the races. There will be no additional seating provided on the pool deck.

WITHDRAWALS

Swimmers not intending to swim or Team Managers that are aware of any swimmers that are not intending to swim, should notify the Recorder prior to the start of the meet. During the meet; swimmers should notify the marshals. **This applies to all distances as any withdrawals may offer us the opportunity to reduce the length of the meet.**

MARSHALLING PROCEDURES

Marshalling will take place in the marshalling room underneath the main grandstand. Swimmers should assemble in the marshalling area two events before their race. The event number being marshalled will be displayed on the electronic screens, however it is the swimmers' responsibility to ensure they marshal on time. We request that all competitors conduct themselves in an orderly and quiet manner while in the marshalling room, to assist our marshals.

STARTING PROCEDURE

The one start rule shall apply for Open and 11 & Over events, 10 & Under and Come & Try events will have a two start rule. Starting over the top for all events except Come & Try, and at the discretion of the Referees.

MULTI – CLASS EVENTS (MC)

All MC events at this meet will be conducted as per SwimmingSA Rules for a swimmer with a disability in competitive swimming.

MEDALS

50m and 100m events: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals for Male and Female in the following categories: 8&U, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15&O. **Multiclass** awarded as a mixed category.

All 200m and 400m events: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals for Male and Female in the following age groups: 13&U, 14&O.

Medals will be available for collection from the MSC Medals Officer on pool deck near the Marshalling Room once the result has been posted. In the event that the Referee amends a result, unfortunately swimmers in such a case will need to hand back medals. Uncollected medals will be retained by MSC for reuse.

SKINS

Male & female swimmers in each Skins age group (13&U, 14&O) will be invited to compete based on the Top 10 performances in **Events 1 and 2**. There was a mix up with the published eligibility criteria, being:

- Entry in the 200mIM, plus at least two more events
- Entry in the 200mIM plus at least two more events, one of which needs to be a 50m event

Athletes who have abided by either of the above criteria will be considered eligible for selection.

SKINS Prize Money for each eligible age group: 1st place \$100 2nd place \$60 3rd place \$35

COME AND TRY CERTIFICATES

All pre-registered Come and Try competitors will be awarded with a Certificate of Participation after the last Come and Try event via a presentation behind the Grandstand.
